RE: Support for Increased Funding of PPP and EIDL Programs

Dear Speaker Pelosi and Leaders McConnell, McCarthy, and Schumer:

On behalf of the members of the Chemung County Chamber of Commerce, I sincerely appreciate the quick action taken to pass the COVID-19 economic relief package known as the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The expansion of major loan programs, including the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) and newly formed Paycheck Protection Program (PPP), is saving millions of jobs and providing much-needed relief to small businesses during this difficult time. Today, I urge you to act quickly once again to appropriate additional funds for the PPP and EIDL programs.

Unfortunately, unprecedented demand has caused both programs to quickly reach their statutory caps. Millions of businesses are at a standstill, with applications still in the pipeline, waiting to see if and when help may come. What’s more, the SBA is unable to accept new applications for either program, leaving countless businesses in the lurch. Small businesses comprise 99.9% of all U.S. businesses, and they are counting on Congress to reach an agreement in order to survive.
